Surgical Pathology Suite Renovation

Project Overview

In order to meet new seismic safety standards and support the current volume of work in the surgical pathology suite, the existing hospital facilities will undergo significant renovations to modernize and enhance the functional capacity of the Surgical Pathology Suite.

As part of this effort, work will begin on the Second Level of 300 Pasteur Drive to renovate and reconfigure the Surgical Pathology Suite.

The 7,300-square-foot expansion and renovation will occur in two phases

in order to maintain operations at all times. Exit routes will be maintained at all times. In the event that hallways temporarily close, detour signage will be posted to indicate the recommended pedestrian route.

- Ergonomic Accessioning Lab with improved workflow
- Expanded slide viewing and slide storage room
- Larger slide sign-out rooms with teleconferencing and multimedia features
- Ventilated tissue storage area
- New administrative area with more office space
- Staff break room
- Improved security access

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Timeline
